Harriman access, Tuesday afternoon August 30. The result of a personal inspection tour by Richard Sumner.

The east end of Rte 106 is closed and badly damaged. The road has obviously been used as a riverbed recently!

Palisades exit 16 is open for Lake Welch Drive only (Tiorati Brook Rd is closed)

Anthony Wayne is closed, for no apparent reason.

The parking off Rte 6 where the long oath crosses is open.

The road to the elk pen is closed.

Rte 106 is closed where it becomes 17a.

The parking lots at the train stations along 17 are open

Seven Lakes Drive is closed at Rte 17.

Kakiat Park is open. A minor washout has been repaired. The bridge is ok.

The road and bridge to the equestrian center on 202 are open.

Diltz Rd parking is open.

Parking where the long path crosses Calls Hollow Rd is open but accessible only from the South (from 202). The bridge between there and Rt 106 is closed

Seven lakes drive is open ONLY between the thruway and the turnaround by Lake Sebago beach entrance. It connects to Lake Welch Drive which is open all the way to exit 16 on the palisades. The bridge between Rte 17 and the Thruway is closed. The only access to Seven Lakes Drive is via Washington St. in Sloatsburg (about 0.6 miles N on 17) and Palisades exit 16 via Lake Welch Drive.

The road to Johnsontown Circle is open and passable (barely). Parking at Reeves visitor center and Sebago boat launch are open.
