1 STATEMENT OF POLICY

The New York-New Jersey Trail Conference is a volunteer-powered organization that builds, maintains, and protects public trails. Together with our partners, we strive to ensure that the trails and natural areas we share are sustainable and *accessible for all to enjoy for generations to come*.

In celebrating people of all skill levels and abilities, we value a diverse community of volunteers, employees, partners, and individuals with a deep connection to nature and a desire to preserve it. Through a broad diversity of experiences and perspectives, we unite under a common purpose to protect the lands we love.

We believe in a diverse membership, board, and staff to establish an open environment inviting to all members of our broad community while empowering them to make a difference. The Trail Conference embraces and selects candidates for employment from a wide variety of backgrounds based on work and life experience as well as degrees and academic progression. Through this approach, we hope to provide a platform to grow the community of trail users and to provide resources to the public, regardless of age, gender, race, socio-economic background, and other common "differences". In our free workshops, we welcome people of all backgrounds to learn and grow in a supportive environment, allowing everyone the opportunity to reach their fullest potential.
